Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 406/498-A of IPC at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 22.08.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the case, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and arrest of the petitioner was stayed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been settled between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide settlement/agreement dated 10.12.2019.

In view of above, since the matter has been settlement between the parties and accordingly, a settlement/agreement dated 10.12.2019 has

been reduced into writing before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the order dated 22.08.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
