Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon the order dated 16.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.13967 of 2016, titled as 'Santosh Kumari & others Vs. State of Punjab & others', to contend that the claim of the petitioner is covered by the said order.

Counsel for the State contends that the petitioner would not be entitled to the benefit as has been claimed by him in this writ petition.
