1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for punishing the respondents for willful disobedience of order dated 28.08.2020, in CWP-13044-2020.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that she has been supplied copy of order dated 26.11.2020, passed by respondent No.1, in compliance with order dated 28.08.2020 in CWP No.13044-2020, therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the Contempt Petition with liberty to challenge order dated 26.11.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
4. The same is not opposed by learned AAG, Punjab.
5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for.
