In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh at Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, to look into and decide representation dated 07.11.2020 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
