Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though instant petition pertains to grant of regular bail to petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. but she may be permitted to withdraw the petition seeking concession of regular bail but confines the claim for grant of medical assistance to the petitioner as on account of amputation of his left leg below the knee, for want of medical assistance in the jail, petitioner is not getting requisite medical treatment.

In view of above, instant petition for grant of regular bail is dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of physical condition of petitioner, as is evident from Annexure P-4, certificate issued by Consultant Incharge, Fortis Hospital Ltd., Amritsar as well as history of patient, as is evident from document Annexure P-6, on account of amputation of left leg below the knee,

petitioner requires medical assistance and follow up treatment as well. In this scenario, Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar with the active assistance of Doctor concerned of said jail, is required to provide requisite medical assistance to under-trial Anoop Singh (petitioner herein) so that no inconvenience is caused to him as in case of amputation of leg, post operative care is of utmost importance.

Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar is required to do the needful at the earliest and requisite medical assistance must be given to petitioner as per ailment.

In these terms, instant petition is disposed of.

Copy of this order be sent to Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar for necessary compliance.
