The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 51 dated 3.12.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 (1) (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station SVB(H), Gurugram, Haryana.

Notice of motion was issued and thereafter vide order dated 19.9.2019, petitioners were directed to join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were directed to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Ram Karan, contends that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 27.9.2019 and they are not required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 19.9.2019 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
