Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The first bail application of the petitioner/accused-Jaswinder Singh bearing No. CRM-M-14402 of 2019 was declined by this Court in a case FIR No. 57 dated 26.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 376, 366 and 450 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Khuhian Sarwar, Tehsil Abohar, District

Fazilka vide detailed order dated 20.05.2019. In spite of the same, the occurrence having taken place on 26.06.2018, the petitioner has shown total arrogance and insolence to the process of law and has been evading his appearance before the investigating agency and rather what stand reflected from his conduct that the petitioner has utilized this time to influence the prosecutrix which is suggestive from the stand of the counsel for the complainant that the parties have settled their dispute. Moreover, during this period, neither the Magistrate nor the Investigating Agency ever made any effort to get declared the petitioner a proclaimed offender or presented the challan, especially, when the offences are of very heinous nature.

In view of such sad state of affairs and what is already observed in the orders of the first bail application, no cause for allowing the present petition is made out and, thus, the same stands dismissed.
