The Court finds that the Petitioner has rushed to this Court by filing the present petition on 25th November, 2020 aggrieved, *inter alia* that the representation submitted by the Petitioner just about a week earlier on 17th November, 2020 to the Union Minister, Ministry of Defence, Government of India has not been responded to.
2. When a pointed question was posed to Mr. Vikas Bahl, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Petitioner, as to why the Petitioner has rushed to the Court without even waiting for a proper response to the above representation, he submitted that an earlier representation made by the Petitioner in May, 2020, had also not been responded to.
3. The Court finds that in the representation made on 17th November, 2020, there is no mention whatsoever of a representation having been submitted earlier in May, 2020. Consequently, the Court is of the view that the present petition is premature and does not warrant any interference at this stage.

4. Accordingly, leaving it open to the Petitioner to follow up on the representation made to the Ministry of Defence, the petition is dismissed.
