The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0053 dated 11.05.2019 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Shambu, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has already paid a sum of Rs.4 lakhs to the complainant and since the complainant was not in possession of the required documents, he failed to get the said vehicle transferred in the name of the petitioner.

When counsel for the petitioner was put a specific query as to where is the truck in question, he has informed that the petitioner has further sold it in *kabad* rags.

Considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
