The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.451 dated 20.08.2005 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

Perusal of the order dated 16.09.2008 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hisar (Annexure P-8) shows that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in the case.

Since the petitioner has already been declared as a proclaimed offender in the case and he has filed a separate petition challenging the order whereby he was declared as a proclaimed offender, this Court finds that the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is not maintainable.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
