The present writ petition is filed for setting aside the orders dated 03.01.2015 (Anexure P-6) and July, 2015 (Anexure P-7), vide which, the services of the petitioner were dismissed and the representation filed by the petitioner against the order of punishment was also dismissed by respondent No.3.

Reply has been filed. As per one of the preliminary objections, the petitioner has concealed the material facts. The petitioner, in fact, did not submit any statutory petition/appeal to any authority under Section 117 (2) of the BSF Act, which he has allegedly submitted to Inspector General BSF, Jalandhar Cantt, Punjab, which was allegedly disposed of in July, 2015, placed on record as Annexure P-7. As per the same, the order was issued on the petition/representation, which is of one Bikramjit Singh of 137 Battalion BSF and the petitioner has simply forged the said order by mentioning his name.

Moreover, the contentions as submitted by the petitioner in this writ petition stand answered in para Nos.2 and 7 of the reply on merits. No replication has been filed till date. In fact, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 27.09.2019 and again on 21.11.2019. Today also, no one is present. It is obvious that the petitioner has nothing to say and does not wish to pursue the writ petition any more.

Dismissed accordingly.
