The petitioner concedes the fact that the petitioner has not even applied for grant of emergency parole and has straight away approached the Court on the basis of legal notice which has been served. He, at this stage, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to first approach the competent authority for grant of emergency parole with a request that a direction be issued to the said authority to decide the application of the petitioner within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for grant of emergency parole to the competent authority. If such an application is made, the same shall be
