All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.431, dated 30.8.2020, having been registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 148/149/323/324 of the IPC (with Sections 325/307/506 of the IPC having been added later on).

No interim order having been passed in favour of the petitioner on the last date of hearing, today Mr.Virk, learned counsel for the State, submits that as per his instructions, in fact it is the petitioner in this case who is attributed an injury dangerous to life on the person of Suresh, with his co-accused Sumit, who has also filed a similar petition which has been

withdrawn today by learned counsel for the petitioner vide a separate order passed today itself, has been attributed a grievous injury on the person of Suman.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition.
