All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail', under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.21, dated 24.02.2020, having been registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 306 of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof, with Section 109 of the IPC added later.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for about 6 months now, the allegations against her being that she alongwith her daughter were instrumental in the deceased, i.e. her son-in-law, committing suicide on account of having allegedly been insulted by his wife and her family.

Upon query to learned State counsel, he does not deny that the petitioner has been in custody for 6 months, with the charge also not framed so far by the trial court (probably due to the ongoing COVID-10 pandemic).

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the petitioner ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
