Prayer in this petition is for quashing of summons/notice dated 07.08.2019 issued under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No. 05 dated 02.01.2019 registered under Sections 403, 409, 415, 420, 463, 464, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly argued that the prosecution agency is not proceeding as per law in the present case. Notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioner to be present in the Police Station for giving his specimen signatures/handwriting but since the petitioner being 69 years old, cannot be asked to do so.

Learned State counsel states that the Investigating Officer himself will approach Sultan Singh Sheoran to taken specimen signatures/handwriting at his address i.e. J-16, Officers Colony, Near Mini Secretariat, Bhiwani, within a period of 10 days of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of accordingly.
