Prayer in this petition is for quashing of summons/notice dated 07.08.2019 issued under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No. 05 dated 02.01.2019 registered under Sections 403, 409, 415, 420, 463, 464, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly argued that the prosecution agency is not proceeding as per law in the present case. Notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioner to be present in the Police Station for giving his specimen signatures/handwriting. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner, who is a practicing Advocate at

Delhi, will himself approach the investigating officer within one week to give his specimen signatures.

Accordingly, petitioner Ashish Sheoran, who is stated to be practicing Advocate at Delhi is directed to approach the Investigating Officer within one week to give his specimen signatures/handwriting.
