Petitioners who are 47 in number and are serving on different Class-IV posts such as Peons, Sweepers, Water Carriers etc. were granted benefit of regularization in service w.e.f. 05.08.2014.

Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus that the benefit of regularization ought to be given w.e.f. 01.04.2011 i.e. the date their juniors have been so regularized.

Upon notice of motion having been issued a reply by way of affidavit of the District Education Officer, Hisar alongwith a speaking order dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure R1) has been filed and placed on record.

A categoric stand has been taken in the written statement as also as per speaking order dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure R-1) the necessary relief has been granted i.e. benefit of regularization of services of the petitioners w.e.f.01.04.2011. Further decision has been taken that the petitioners be also paid arrears of pay for the period in question i.e.01.04.2011 to 2014.

In view of the above writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

It is, however, observed that in case the arrears of salary for the period in question have not already been released, the same be paid to the petitioners without any further delay.
