Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner Honey Sidhu who had been declared as a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.107 dated 05.05.2011, for offences under Sections 223 and 224 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana had applied for grant of pre-arrest bail. His such petition bearing No.CRM-M-3373-2020 was disposed of, vide order dated 02.03.2020 with a direction to the petitioner to appear in the trial Court within one week and then move application for regular bail, which be decided by the trial Court within two weeks. It was further ordered that till then he may not be arrested. Admittedly, the petitioner had not appeared before the trial Court within the stipulated time, as directed vide order dated 02.03.2020. Now, he has filed a second petition for pre-arrest bail, contending that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court

since his brother had expired and thereafter, a lock down was imposed in the whole country. The explanation given does not appear to be satisfactory. In any case, the second petition for pre-arrest bail is not maintainable. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
