This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.201 dated 20.05.2019, under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station, Azad Nagar, District Hisar. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 26.08.2019, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Notice of motion for 24.10.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided

under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Ramesh Kumar, has apprised the Court that after completion of investigation, the petitioner (accused) was found innocent and was accordingly placed in column No.2 in the final report dated 26.08.2019 filed under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
