Present petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents and also to take appropriate action against the persons which have been mentioned in the head note of the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had submitted representation vide Annexure P-1 to the Director General of Police (Punjab) as well as to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Jalandhar, District Jalandhar but no action has been taken in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S.Sitta, Asst.AG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State – respondents No.1 to 4 and on instructions has stated that the representation of the petitioner has already been marked to the concerned police official for the purpose of taking appropriate action and the same is in process.

In view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press his prayers at this stage and he will be satisfied in case the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police to expedite the process on his representation and to take action in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the factual position which has been explained by the learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 SHO, Police Station Kartarpur, Distirct Jalandhar to proceed on the basis of representation in accordance with law and take appropriate action in case, if it is so required as per law.

Disposed of.
