Present petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the representation submitted by the petitioner on 15.10.2020 and for various other directions including the protection of life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was grievously injured by respondents No.4 and 5 by tress-passing into his house at village Kamalpur, District Sangrur on 01.10.2020 and the reason behind the attack was that both the above stated respondents are the local goons of the area and they used to molest and stalk his wife and when

he asked them to stop doing such acts then they attacked him and threatened him. He has further submitted that he has approached the police authorities number of times but no action has been taken by the police in this regard. He has also submitted that he gave representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur on 15.10.220 vide Annexure P-3 but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S.Sitta, Asst.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State – respondents No.1 to 3 and states that State has no objection in case the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the matter and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this Court is satisfied that there is no necessity to call for the reply of the State at this stage and it will be in the interest of justice to direct the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the representation made by the petitioner vide Annexure P-3 and to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certificied copy of this order.
