The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 151, dated 10.07.2019, under Sections 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on a perusal of the FIR in question, it is clearly evident that only general and vague allegations have been levelled against the petitioner and his entire family and moreover, the ingredients of Section 306 IPC too are not made out.

Learned State counsel on the other hand while opposing the petition has submitted that the petitioner along with the co-accused had been indulging in character assassination of the deceased and levelling false allegations against her, which drove her to end her life.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
