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**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J (ORAL)**

The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.53 dated 21.05.2018, under Section 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahar, District S.B.S. Nagar on the basis of compromise dated 25.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) arrived at, between the parties.

Parties are present in person and apprised the Court that they are residing together as husband and wife.

Vide order dated 29.08.2019 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

Report has since been received from the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, in pursuance to the direction of this Court. As per the report, compromise has indeed been effected between the parties and the same is without any inducement, coercion or pressure. The trial Court has annexed the original copy of the statements of

the parties along with its report.

Learned State counsel also submits that there are no other accused other than the petitioner and respondent No.2 is the only aggrieved person in the FIR in question.

In view of the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, and the principles laid down by the Apex Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the instant petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.

Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
