[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per information received by him vide Memo No.DULB/Estt./3E/2019/8291 dated 04.02.2020 from the Director General Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, Panchkula, the petitioner was allowed to appear in the departmental examination and on the basis of relaxation given pursuant to declaration of result, the petitioner has been promoted to the next higher post i.e. the post of Accountant, therefore, the writ petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such. Copy of the communication along with annexure attached thereto is taken on record.

[2] None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

[3] In the circumstances, in the light of the statement of learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** as having become infructuous.
