Petitioners Mukhtiar Singh and others have brought the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. against respondents i.e. State of Haryana through its Secretary, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural), SHO, Police Station Lohian Khas, District Jalandhar (Rural) as well as against private respondents No.4 to 17 for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against private respondents No.4 to 17 on the representations dated 18.11.2020

(Annexure P-2) and dated 23.11.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural) is directed to consider the representations Annexure P2 and Annexure P3 submitted by the petitioners and take necessary action in the matter.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents No.1 to 3 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural) to consider the representations Annexure P2 and Annexure P3 and to take necessary action in the matter, in accordance with law if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case, expeditiously.
