The petitioners have approached this Court, by way of filing the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking protection of their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1 Jaswinder Kaur is married to respondent No. 4 Jagdev Singh and on account of their troubled relationship, she had filed a divorce petition in November, 2019 on the ground of cruelty, however, the same was withdrawn on 29.01.2020 as respondent No. 4 assured that he will mend his ways. Later on, since respondent No. 4 did not improve his behaviour, the petitioner left the matrimonial home and started living with petitioner No. 2 Sandeep Singh and they are in live-in-relationship.

Admittedly, petitioner No. 1 Jaswinder Kaur is a married woman, who without seeking divorce from respondent No. 4, is living with petitioner No. 2 Sandeep Singh. She has an alternative remedy of approaching Family Court for seeking divorce from her husband-respondent

No. 4. This Court cannot put a seal on such type of adulterous relationship between the petitioners.

Accordingly, finding no ground to entertain the present petition, the same is dismissed.
