This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 21.5.2019 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, vide which the application filed by the petitioner for releasing his vehicle on superdari was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 23.5.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 12972 of 2019 and CRM-M No. 15089 of 2019 in the case of co-accused, vide which it was directed that instead of furnishing bank guarantee of Rs.8,00,000/- each, two solvent sureties of the equivalent amount will be furnished and the petitioner(s) therein will hand over the Registration Certificate with the Investigating Agency along with an undertaking that the

Registration Certificate of the vehicle(s) will remain in possession of the Court and petitioner(s) will not sell or alienate the cars by creating third party interest during the pendency of the trial.

Since the vehicle(s) were released on superdari by the trial Court in the aforesaid cases, therefore, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhagwan Singh, has no objection in case the impugned order is set aside and the vehicle in question i.e. SUV Jeep Compass bearing Registration No. HR-12A G-9057 is released on superdari in favour of the petitioner on the same terms and conditions as were incorporated while releasing the other vehicles on superdari by the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
