Petitioner seeks interim bail for 10 days in FIR No.122 dated 30.10.2018 (wrongly mentioned as 29.10.2018 in the impugned order Annexure P-3), under Sections 27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 120-B, 148, 149, 302, 307, 323, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bapoli, District Panipat, for attending and arranging the marriage function of his only brother-in-law (Pankaj) and for performing the customary rites and rituals of his marriage i.e. from 03.12.2020 to 12.12.2020.

Notice of motion.

Mr. RKS Brar, Additional AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The prayer for interim bail has been declined by the Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat on 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-3) on the

ground that there was no plea of the applicant that there was no other male member to look after the arrangement. The wedding arrangement of the marriage of brother-in-law of the petitioner is to be looked after by the bride side and release of the petitioner can raise tension in the village and he can put pressure on the witnesses.

Counsel thus submitted that petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2018 i.e. the date of registration of the FIR and the petitioner would join only the marriage ceremony of his brother-in-law.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that interim bail to the petitioner is liable to be granted only to the extent that he be permitted to join the marriage function at Cozette Hotel, Balgarh Road, Sonipat which is to be held on Sunday, dated 6th December, 2020 as per the wedding card attached. The petitioner shall be taken to the said venue in the custody of police squad from District Jail, Panipat at 02:00 p.m. on 06.12.2020 and shall be brought back to the jail till 12:00 p.m. on 07th December, 2020 by the said police party. He shall not be permitted to be taken at the place of his residence/where the incident took place.

The present petition is disposed of with the above said directions.
