Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 20 dated 26.03.2019 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the CCTV footage dated 26.03.2019 at 11.19 AM, the vehicle in question-white Verna car was shown to be going on wrong side and later on it was met with an accident with police vehicle. The petitioner was carrying contraband and a secret information was received at 7.10 PM and the same was recovered from the white Verna car, thus accordingly the FIR was registered at 9.35 P.M.

Vide order dated 29.08.2019, Coordinate Bench of this Court has directed the SSP, Tarn Taran, to inquire into the matter and file an

affidavit to this aspect.

As per the affidavit, the petitioner was found in possession of 10400 tablets containing salt Alprazolam and Tramadol Hydrochloride, whereas the petitioner was arrested on 29.03.2019 and vide order dated 29.08.2019 he was released on interim bail.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the order dated 29.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
