Since the allegations in the two FIRs are entirely different, therefore, the plea of the petitioner that it was a case of double jeopardy, was rightly rejected by the Courts below.

Both the orders passed by the Courts below are detailed and well reasoned. They do not come out to suffer from any illegality or infirmity much less apparent on the face of those orders. The present petition does not fall within four corners of Section 482 Cr.P.C. No ground is there to interfere with the impugned orders while exercising jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition being without merit stands dismissed accordingly.
