Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are stated to be run away couple and apprehend threat and harassment at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.5 to 11.

On a pointed query put to learned counsel for the petitioners as to whether any missing report had been lodged by the family members of petitioner No.2 since she admittedly is a minor, aged 16 years, learned counsel for the petitioners has feigned ignorance about the same and is rather evasive to the query put.

In the circumstances and more so keeping in mind the fact that petitioner No.2 is admittedly a minor, no ground is made out to extend the relief sought for.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
