This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to pass speaking orders on the representations dated 9.4.2018 and 22.10.2020 (Annexures P-10 and P-13 respectively), submitted by the petitioner; in a time bound manner.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been working as a PGT Physical Education under the respondents. Since the respondents had issued certain notifications for the appointed candidates to acquire qualifications within extended period, whereas the petitioner was already having an equivalent qualification with a different nomenclature, therefore, the petitioner has approached the respondents for clarification qua the equivalent of the qualifications of the petitioner vis-a-vis the qualifications required for the post by the respondents. That representations are still pending with the respondents.

At this stage, the counsel submits that the petitioner would be

satisfied if his representations are considered and decided by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deipa Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that she is not averse to expeditious disposal of the representations of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a decision on the representations dated 9.4.2018 and 22.10.2020 (Annexures P-10 and P-13 respectively) and to pass a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
