Asha Devi and others have filed the instant appeal seeking additional compensation with regard to death of Kuldeep @ Deepu in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 11.12.2011 on Kabri road, Panipat.

The Tribunal awarded compensation to the tune of Rs.2,80,000/- payable with interest.

Counsel representing Reliance General Insurance Company (hereinafter referred to as the 'insurance company') has submitted that dispute between the appellants and insurance company has been settled by way of compromise and in view thereof, the insurance company has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.3 lakh as full and final settlement, in addition to compensation assessed by the Tribunal. He would further submit that the insurance company would deposit the additional amount of R.3 lakh in compliance with directions of this Court.

Counsel for the appellants would concede to the factum of compromise between the parties on payment of Rs.3 lakh as additional

compensation. He would further state additional compensation of Rs.3 lakh may be paid only to mother of deceased, Asha Devi.

Counsel for the insurance company has got no objection.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of, in terms of compromise between the parties. Counsel for the appellants is directed to supply the latest address of Asha Devi to counsel for the insurance company within seven days. The insurance company shall prepare a demand draft of Rs.3 lakh in the name of mother of the deceased and hand it over to her positively within a period of one month from today.
