The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of bail in case FIR No.303, dated 07.09.2020, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 19985, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, during pendency of trial.

In compliance to the order dated 04.12.2020 of this Court, verification report dated 09.12.2020, by way of affidavit of Sh. Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dhuri, District Sangrur, on behalf of the State, has been filed through e-mail . Same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

A perusal of the aforesaid verification report reveals that marriage of the petitioner's niece is indeed fixed for 13.12.2020 at Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would restrict his prayer for concession of interim bail to the petitioner for just two days, so as to enable him to join the marriage of his niece.

On the other hand, learned State counsel too admits the factum of marriage of the niece of the petitioner.

Heard.

In the circumstances, the instant petition stands disposed of and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on 12.12.2020 for a period of two days to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall surrender back in the jail, where he is currently lodged on the evening of 13.12.2020 before 06:00 P.M.
