Vide this common order we shall dispose of above said four writ petition since common question of law is involved therein.

For the sake of convenience facts have been taken from CWP No.27648-2018.

This appeal has been filed for quashing of order dated 21.9.2018 whereby the representation of the petitioner dated 8.8.2018 pursuant to the order passed by this Court passed in CWP No.10885-2018 claiming refund of license fee with interest on account of the facts narrated therein has been dismissed.

On the last date the following order was passed :-

*“Learned counsel for the respondents state that as a matter of fact this petition has been rendered infrutuous since now the appellate authority has been set up.*

*Counsel for the petitioner seeks time to respond.*

*Adjourned to 21.1.2020.*

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not press this petition and would file an appeal but prays that limitation should not be permitted to come in the way.
