Case has been taken up through video conferencing in view of the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

2. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of Regular Bail to the petitioner in Case FIR No.75 dated 29.06.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 379-B, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

3. The petitioner has remained in detention since 18.09.2020.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner stands on the same footing as co-accused-AmritPal Singh @ Kaka and Jaspreet Singh @ Jassa @ Bongo, who have been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2020 and 02.12.2020 in case bearing **CRM-M No.37667 of 2020** and

**CRM-M No.38904 of 2020** respectively.

5. Considering all the above circumstances and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, and in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
