Case has been taken up through video conferencing in view of the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

2. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of Regular Bail to the petitioner in Case FIR No.0106 dated 04.07.2020, registered under Sections 166A, 295A, 323, 342 IPC and 3(1) (iv), 3(1)(v), 4 of SC and the ST (Prevention of atrocities) Act, 1989, Section 67 Punjab Police Act, 2007, Section 66 (E) and Section 67(A) of Information Technology Act, 2000, Police Station City Khanna.

3. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than 03 months

since 15.09.2020.

4. After completion of investigation, challan was filed against him.

5. Considering all the above circumstances and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, and in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
