SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

After hearing both sides and considering that the petitioner who is on bail and is not reported to be involved in any other case of similar nature, this Court is of the view that an opportunity should be granted to him to lead the defence evidence from his side, more particularly, in view of the submission that being a third party to the FIR No.10 dated 17.01.2018 of which he wanted the judicial record to be summoned, he is not in a position to obtain certified copies of the documents retained in that particular case record.

The present revision is, therefore, allowed with a liberty to the petitioner to complete his evidence at his own risk by way of summoning the relevant witnesses. But this shall not be a ground to delay the matter inordinately for long time. The Ld. trial Court would be well within its rights to close the petitioner's defence evidence in case he fails to secure presence of his witnesses on the date as granted to him.
