Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is apprehending threats and harassment at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide his representation dated 10.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) filed by him in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. A.A.Pathak, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.3 – SSP, Kapurthala to look into the representation dated 10.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously

as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
