The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0577 dated 05.10.2017, registered under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

As per allegations in FIR, 4 Kg of charas wrapped in a ploythene was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Taking into account the quantity of contraband recovered, it is not possible to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 05.10.2017. He further states that defence evidence has been closed and matter is fixed for arguments. Even written arguments have been submitted as is clear from the order dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-2).

After having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a request to the learned trial Court to endeavour to finally dispose of the case at the earliest.
