Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for the release of detenue-Ramkoshliya, wife of the petitioner, who is alleged to have been illegally detained by respondent No.4 to 7, by appointing a Warrant Officer.

Vide order dated 03.12.2020, the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, had been directed to depute a police officer for visiting the house of respondents No.4 to 7 and make an inquiry as to whether the alleged detenue was residing there with her own consent or had been detained by the private respondent illegally or forcibly.

In compliance of the order dated 03.12.2020, status report by way of affidavit of the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, has been filed in the Registry. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel draws the attention of this Court towards the statement dated 08.12.2020 (Annexure R-4/T) of the alleged detainee, recorded by HC Neeru Bala and ASI Jasbir Singh, annexed with the status report, wherein she stated that she is residing happily in her maternal grand-father's house and she does not want to reside with the petitioner. She also stated that nobody had illegally detained her; that she is residing there of her own free will, and that their family members are not harassing her.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present criminal writ petition.

Dismissed.
