The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 4.12.2020, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Reply by way of affidavit of Balbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala has been filed by the State wherein it has been mentioned that both the petitioners are living happily and do not want any kind of protection.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
