B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating proceedings against respondent No.2 for intentional and willful disobedience of order dated 04.11.2020, in CWP-18510-2020.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 04.11.2020, in CWP-18510-2020, operation of order dated 14.10.2020 for replacing outsourced manpower at CHC, Kaul, was stayed but respondent No.2 did not permit the petitioner to join duty in terms of the aforementioned order, therefore, the instant Contempt Petition was filed praying for initiation of contempt proceedings against respondent No.2. Learned counsel, however, fairly concedes that today the petitioner has been allowed to join duty at CHC, Kaul and that in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the Contempt Petition.
4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.
5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
