HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

In the present writ petition, the petitioner is raising claim against the Central Co-operative Bank, which is a Society.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises a preliminary objection with regard to the maintainability of the present writ petition before this Court, keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CWP No.6776 of 1999 titled as **Ranjit Singh vs. The Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh and another** decided on 13.08.2010.

Learned counsel for the respondent argues that even the Punjab State Co-operative Bank has been held to be a co-operative society and, therefore, is not amenable to writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail the appropriate remedy under the Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
