After arguing for some time, realizing that the Court was not convinced with the contentions raised by him and was not inclined to grant the relief prayed for, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition for pre-arrest bail since the petitioner would surrender before the police, however, he has requested that a direction be issued to the Court concerned to decide the application for regular bail moved on behalf of the petitioner expeditiously. He has further contended that it is a family dispute and the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the present complainant, who happens to be his real brother.

Dismissed as withdrawn. It is observed that on petitioner surrendering before the police and moving application for regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously by the Court concerned.
