1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for punishing the respondents for intentional and willful disobedience of order Annexure P/1 dated 18.02.2020, in CRWP-1620-2019.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 18.02.2020, CRWP-1620-2019 was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide application dated 5.10.2018 qua premature release of the petitioner in accordance with the policy applicable within two months but despite lapse of aforementioned period of time, needful was not done, therefore, the instant contempt petition was filed. However, learned counsel states that he has been supplied copy of order dated 16.12.2020 passed by respondent No.1 deciding the application of the petitioner for premature release and that in view thereof, the petitioner does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
