Challenge in the instant petition is to the order pronounced on 8.4.2015 at Annexure P-5 by the Additional Registrar (General), Cooperative Societies, Punjab pursuant to a revision petition filed under Section 69 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 at the hands of the instant petitioner.

By virtue of the impugned order the matter has been remanded back to the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Patiala for passing an order afresh.

It would be apposite to take note that vide order dated 15.9.2015 passed by this Court directions were issued for proceedings before the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Patiala to be not finalized.

During the course of hearing today counsel for the petitioner would confine the scope of the instant petition as regards issuance of directions to the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Patiala to pass a final order pursuant to remand order expeditiously and within a stipulated

time frame.

Learned State counsel does not oppose such prayer.

In view of the above and without even opining on the merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to decide the matter and to pass an order afresh pursuant to the impugned remand order at Annexure P-5 expeditiously and in any case within a period of six weeks from today.

Parties are directed to appear before respondent no.2 on 19.2.2020.

Needless to observe that in the eventuality of respondent no.2 upholding the order of Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies the consequential benefits would be released to the petitioner without any further delay.

Disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
