This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the respondent-UOI and respondent No.5 bring to my notice that the guidelines attached as Annexure P-2 are not applicable in the present case. The said guidelines and norms are for access permission to Fuel Stations etc., along the National Highway, while the site in question is not on the national highway. In NOC, Annexure P-1, reference has been thus made to IRC-12-2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that IRC-12-2016 is identical to the guidelines attached as Annexure P-2. However, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file afresh with proper pleadings.

Petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
