SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.01 dated 04.01.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

2. The petitioner was initially arrested on 04.01.2019, after which, he was granted interim bail by the trial Court, which order subsequently recalled in view of the fact that FSL report was received later on. Thereafter, the petitioner surrendered himself before the learned Trial Court on 23.07.2019 and has remained in detention. The total period of detention undergone by the petitioner comes to 9 months including the period initially undergone by him. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under NDPS Act.

4. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
