The hearing of this petition has been taken up through video conferencing on account of outbreak of Corona Virus (Covid-19) Pandemic.

Through the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the official respondents to get the detainee, namely, Rani, daughter of the petitioner released from the illegal confinement of respondents No.4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the daughter of the petitioner has been forcibly taken away by the private respondents

No.4 to 9 on 15.10.2019 and she made a complaint to the SHO, Mauli Jagran. But the police officials did not get her daughter released.

Notice of motion was issued to officials respondents No.1 to 3 and in response, they have filed a status report by way of affidavit of Shri Juldan Singh, Inspector, Station House Officer, Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh. It has been submitted in the status report that the alleged detainee, Mamta had filed a petition, CRWP No.8407 of 2020 jointly, with Asif son of Wasim wherein it had been stated that they have performed marriage against the wishes of the parents and family members of the alleged detainee and there is a threat from them. The petition was disposed of by this Court on 15.10.2020 with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action, in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

In view of the aforestated position, no direction is required to be issued. The petition is dismissed.
